

## Concealed Weapons Carry Training Provider (Instructor) Requirements

The requirements for this are very similar to the BSIS process, only much more tedious. In addition to the tough vetting process by completing a *separate* Live Scan, the Orange County Sheriff's Department (OCSD) provides a very basic and vague framework stating that the applicant has to provide his/her own training material and submit it for approval as long as it has the following (paraphrase):

1. *Written Exam covering the manipulation, maintenance, laws, penal codes and proper usage of firearms and its mechanics*

2. *Live Fire Exam to prove the competency of the shooter with a holster. The bare minimum requirements for the live fire exam can be found at the orange county sheriff's website*
  3. *Complete serialized certification system that has a traceable serial number, caliber information, students name and very specific wording on the completion certificate that is acceptable by the OCSD.*
  4. *Have a pre-existing firearm instructor certification from the NRA or a state, local or federally recognized firearm instructor license.*
  5. *Verification of business and home addresses by providing utility bill statements over a specified period of time as well as a copy of a current Driver License.*

Once all this original work is completed, it was submitted to the OCSD CCW Licensing unit for review and approval. Individuals and/or companies that submit bare minimum requirements into the OCSD will likely be rejected.
